Why the need for English teachers?

Understanding and speaking English is in HIGH demand in Peru. If a student wants to go to a good university and have a successful job when they graduate, they need to know English.

Because of this pressing need, teaching English is a great tool that can be used to spread the gospel.

If a school offers a good English program it allows the educational ministries to improve not only their academics, but also their enrollment and therefore their outreach.

Why Pioneer Christian School?

Pioneer Christian School was founded by an American missionary couple who had the vision to create a ministry that would be a shining light in a dark city.

Throughout the years, many children and parents have come to know Christ as their Savior because of this small Christian school.

To this day, the school maintains its ministry mindset. There is an annual mission trip with the students and other evangelistic outreaches throughout the year.

Come be a part of this ministry and you will see young minds being molded not only academically, but also spiritually on a daily basis. You will also be able to strengthen your relationship with the Lord as you serve Him in Lima, Peru.

Teacher Requirements

An English teacher at Pioneer Christian School must be a Christian, a member of a local church, and a native English speaker. A teaching degree is preferred but not necessary.

Housing

An apartment, two blocks from the school, is rented out to the American teachers. Rent is \$400 a month and food is about \$200 a month.



Income

The school pays its English teachers \$600 a month. You will be able to teach private classes for additional income. We suggest that a teacher raise about \$500 a month of support in order to cover additional expenses.
